Resham Singh versus State of Punjab

ORDER:

1. Heard on anticipatory bail application filed by applicant Resham Singh alias Rinku son of Thakur Singh in FIR no.124 dated 15.08.2024, u/s 331(4), 305, 299, 61(2), 317(2), 238 BNS, Police Station City Khanna.

2. Relevant facts are that applicant absented from the court proceedings on 17.12.2025. His bail order were cancelled. His personal bail bonds and surety bonds also cancelled and forfeited to State. Arrest warrants were issued to procure his presence. He was declared proclaimed offender on 07.05.2026. It has been argued that applicant was lying arrested in another FIR at Faridabad and Karnataka but admittedly Court was not intimated. No reason given for not intimating the Court of reason for his absence. No exemption application or application for issuance of production warrants has been moved. Challan was presented on 18.10.2024. Charge was framed on 07.12.2024. Thus for

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want of presence of applicant proceedings before the trial court in said FIR could not be concluded.

3. Applicant has no respect for rule of law. He has been declared proclaimed offender. Applicant is seeking anticipatory bail after being declared proclaimed person. Hon'ble Supreme Court has held in case titled **Lavesh versus State (NCT) at Delhi: 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 240 SC** and **Prem Shankar Parsad Vs. The State of Bihar: 2021(4) RCR(Criminal) 598 (SC)** that anticipatory bail application is not maintainable when accused stands declared proclaimed offender.

4. In view of above said case law and considering the facts and circumstances of present case present anticipatory bail application is not found maintainable. Thus present application is without any merit and stands dismissed. Lower court record be sent back alongwith copy of this order. Bail papers be consigned to the record room.
