This petition is filed U/s. 13 B of the HMA.

This petition having been finally heard on 08.08.2025 and stood over for consideration on 16.08.2025 and on the same day the court delivered the following:

JUDGMENT

Petition filed under Sec.13 (B) of Hindu Marriage Act 1955 seeking dissolution of marriage.

2. According to the petitioners, they got married as per custom of the community on 04/06/2012. Thereafter they lived together as husband and wife till 01/04/2019. Owing to strong differences of opinion their marital relationship has irretrievably broken down and there is no chance of a reunion. Two children were born in their wedlock. There is no collusion between the parties in seeking divorce.

Accordingly, they have mutually agreed to seek for a decree of divorce. Thus the petition.

3.The petitioners have undergone counselling, where also the efforts to settle the dispute have failed. Petitioners filed proof affidavit and they were examined as PW1 and PW2. The marriage certificate was marked as Ext. A1.

4. The point for consideration is,

Whether the marriage of the petitioners is liable to be dissolved ?

5. The Point:- Petitioners seek for divorce by mutual consent. Their marriage was on 04/06/2012 and they lived together as husband and wife till 1/4/2019. Thereafter they are living separately. Their marital relationship has irretrievably broken down and it has become practically and emotionally difficult for them to live together. The efforts to bring them to a settlement and live together by counselling has failed. The petitioners in their proof affidavit filed in support of the petition affirmed that there is no collusion or external interference of any sort in filing the petition for divorce. It is also affirmed that there is no other monetary liability between the parties. In the circumstance I feel it proper to allow divorce as prayed for.

In the result, the petition is allowed and a decree is granted dissolving the marriage between the petitioners solemnized on 04/06/2012 from the date of this judgment.
