Fresh DAR filed by the IO. Let it be checked and registered.

Present: IO SI Lokender in person.
Sh. Nitin Sharma, Ld. counsel for the Petitioner/ injured along with petitioner Sh. Adil Khan in person.
Respondent no. 1/ driver cum owner Vishwas Singh joined through VC.
Sh. H.L Dagar, proxy counsel for Sh. Afaq Sherwani, Ld. counsel for the respondent no. 2 insurance company.

The respondent no. 1 who has joined through VC proceedings has been identified by the IO. Respondent no. 1 submits that he was not aware that he was required to be present physically today.

Memo of appearance filed on behalf of the insurance company.

Fresh vakalatnama has been filed on behalf of the injured. Be taken on record.

There is delay in filing the DAR. The IO to furnish the written explanation duly forwarded by the SHO concerned on the next date of hearing.

In view of Articles 21 & 22 of the Procedure for Investigation of Motor Vehicle Accidents (See Rule 150A), Central Motor Vehicles (fifth Amendment) Rules 2022, the DAR is treated as claim petition u/s 166, Motor Vehicles Act 1988.

As the DAR has been treated as a claim petition u/s 166 (4) and section 140 of the MV Act therefore petitioner is directed to file a memo of parties on the NDOH reflecting himself as petitioner and with full details of the respondents of the present case.

Copies of the DAR have been supplied to the parties present.

Since the insurance company has put in its appearance today, it is directed to examine DAR and file an appropriate response in the prescribed Form in terms of the Articles 26 & 31 of Procedure for Investigation of Motor Vehicle Accidents (See Rule 150A), Central Motor Vehicles (fifth Amendment) Rules, 2002 in this Tribunal within 30 days with advance copy to the petitioner. R-2/ Insurance Company shall also furnish its complete bank details in the WS. In case of default/delay in filing of the said response, appropriate costs shall be imposed upon the insurance company.

The respondent no. 1 is directed to be present either personally or through counsel on the next date of hearing so that the copy of the DAR may be supplied to him.

The petitioner may file statement of facts in the prescribed Form G. Delhi MACT Rules, 2008 within next 14 working days from today with advance copy to opposite party.

The petitioner is directed to open a bank account in nationalized bank near his place of residence and to place on record the photocopy of their passbooks, adhar card and pan card on the NDOH. The concerned bank is also directed not to issue any cheque book or debit card and to make an endorsement in this regard on the passbook of the petitioner itself. A copy of this order be given dasti to the petitioner to submit the same before the concerned bank.

Put up for supply of the copy of the DAR to the respondent no. 1, exploring the possibility of settlement if any, filing of reply by the respondent no. 2 insurance company and further proceedings on **18.09.2026**.
