A fresh Detailed Accident Report (DAR) received by way of assignment from the Facilitation Centre. It be checked and registered.

A. *Vakalatnama* filed on behalf of petitioner. Memo of Appearance filed on behalf of R-2/insurance company. The same are taken on record.

Let the IO submit a fresh Victim Form after including the name of the mother of the deceased. The IO is further directed to verify the age of the deceased.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have not filed any claim petition anywhere in India in respect of the present road accident.

In view of the said submission and in accordance with Section 166(4) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, the DAR filed by the IO shall be treated as a claim petition under Section 166(4) of the said Act.

Let a copy of the DAR be supplied to the parties.

The respondents are directed to file their written statement(s) within 30 days from today, with an advance copy thereof to be supplied to the petitioners at least one week prior to the next date of hearing.

C. Direction regarding Bank Account

The petitioners (Ms. Babita Devi, Ms. Soniya Kumari, Sh. Monu Kumar, Sh. Sonu Kumar, Ms. Rani Kumari) are directed to open their savings bank accounts in a nationalized bank near their respective places of residence.

The Manager of the concerned bank is directed not to issue any cheque book and/or debit card to the petitioners. If the same has already been issued, the bank shall cancel the same and make an endorsement on the passbooks of the petitioners to the effect that no cheque book and/or debit card shall be issued to the petitioners without the permission of this Tribunal.

The petitioners are directed to produce a copy of this order before the concerned bank, whereupon the bank shall make the aforesaid endorsement on their passbooks.

The petitioners are further directed to produce their passbooks bearing the aforesaid endorsement, along with their Aadhaar Cards and PAN Cards, before this Tribunal.

D. Delay in filing of DAR

It is noticed that there is a delay in the filing of the DAR.

The IO is directed to file his written explanation, duly forwarded by the SHO, regarding the delay in filing the DAR on the next date of hearing.

Be put up for replies of respondents; written explanation, verification of age of deceased and fresh Victim Form by the IO on 08.09.2026.
