Accused Ravi Kant on police bail represented by Sh. Ravinder Battra (Legal Aid Counsel).

Challan presented today before me being Illaqa Magistrate. It be checked and registered. Copies of challan supplied to the accused free of costs as envisaged under section 207 of Cr. PC. Arguments on charge heard. The allegations against the accused are qua violation of the orders dated 23.03.2020 issued by District Magistrate, SAS Nagar qua the lockdown/Curfew qua Covid-19. A prima facie case for the commission of offence under section 188 of Indian penal Code is made out against the accused. Charge framed accordingly to which the accused pleaded guilty and not claimed trial. Accused showed their willingness to confess their guilt. The court is satisfied that the accused have confessed to their guilt voluntarily and without pressure from any side. Therefore, the court holds the accused guilty for the commission of offence punishable under section 188 of Indian Penal Code. Let, the convicts be heard on the quantum of sentence.
