Challan presented today. It be checked and registered.

Accused Ajeet, Baldev and Renu produced before me along-with challan.

Thereafter, an application along-with vakalatnama for seeking regular bail of applicants/accused Ajeet, Baldev and Renu moved. Notice of the same given to State. Reply not filed. Arguments heard on bail application. Perusal of the case file reveals that the trial of the case will take a long time and no recovery is pending against them. Moreover, it is also a well settled principle that bail is the rule and jail is exception. Thus, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused behind the bars. Hence, without commenting on the merits of the case, accused Ajeet, Baldev and Renu are admitted to bail on their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each with one surety in the like amount subject to the conditions which are also mentioned as follows:

(a) that they shall attend in accordance with the conditions of the bond executed and

(b) that they shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence.

Requisite bonds furnished on behalf of accused Ajeet and Baldev which are accepted and attested.

Necessary endorsement on the documents furnished as security by surety be made or as the case may be, intimation in this regard to concerned authority be sent and Reader is directed to maintain computerised data of all particulars of the sureties as well as details of the properties furnished as security, as is required by the Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 01.06.2018 passed in CWP No.4898 of 2018.

Requisite bonds in the shape of FDR bearing account No.140206346521/1 dated 09.01.2025 furnished on behalf of accused Renu which is accepted and attested. FDR placed on record. Intimation in this re-

gard be sent to concerned bank.

Further, in view of order dated 20.01.2025 passed by Ld. JMFC, Gurugram; original passports are handed over to accused Renu and Baldev. Photo-copy of the passports of accused Renu and Baldev are retained on the court file.

Copy of challan supplied to accused Baldev, Ajeet and Renu free of costs as envisaged under Section 207 Cr.P.C and statement in this regard has been recorded separately.

Now, to come up on **05.08.2025** for consideration on charge.
