ORDER

This order of mine shall dispose of anticipatory bail application under section 482 BNSS filed on behalf of applicants/accused (described in detail herein above). It is pleaded and argued that FIR No. 32 dated 29-05-2023 under sections 406, 498-A has been registered at police station Women, District Ludhiana and the applicants have been involved in the said FIR on the basis of false allegations levelled by complainant in collusion with police officials. The applicants being family members and relatives of the husband of complainant apprehend their arrest at the hands of police officials in connivance with the complainant. The applicants are ready to join any kind of investigation. Hence, prayer for grant of anticipatory bail is made.

2. Pursuant to receipt of notice, ASI Harjinder Singh, P.S. Women, Ludhiana put appearance in the court and suffered statement to the effect that applicants/accused are not named in the above-mentioned FIR.

3. Heard. Presently there is no FIR registered against applicants/accused and hence there cannot be any apprehension of arrest of the applicants at this stage.

4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, present bail application stands dismissed being infructuous. File be consigned to the Judicial Record Room, after due compliance.
