The matter is fixed for service of the notices of the petition under section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, an application for stay of execution and another application under section 34 (3) of Arbitration and Conciliation Act for seeking condonation of delay in filing of this objection petition. The notices issued to the respondent are not received back.

The notice for requisition of the record of Ld. Arbitrator was also issued, but, the said notice is also not received back.

Today, Sh. Harshit Soni, Ld. counsel for Respondent has appeared and filed vakalatnama and copy of resolution of board. Since, the record of the Ld. Arbitrator has not been received nor the notice issued to the Ld. Arbitrator has been received. So, fresh notices are ordered to be issued to the Ld. Arbitrator through all modes for sending the complete record of arbitration to this court. The petitioner is directed to take steps for the same within four days from today. Accordingly, matter stands adjourned for **12.10.2026**.

At this stage, Ld. counsel for Respondent has submitted that respondent did not receive legible copies of page number 45 to 48, so, the petitioner may be directed to supply the legible copies thereof. On this, the petitioner has supplied the legible copies thereof to the Ld. counsel for Respondent.
