Order No. 12 dated 04.08.2026

Today is fixed for hearing of petition u/s 151 of CPC.

Both sides file hazira.

The case record is taken up for hearing of petition u/s 151 of CPC.

Heard both sides.

Perused the petition, W/O and other materials available on record.

Considered.

On perusal of the case record it transpires that on 28.08.2025, an order of ad interim injunction was passed by which the defendants are restrained from entering into the suit property or disturbing the plaintiff from peaceful possession or dispossessing him without due process of law. Defendants appeared on 06.09.2025 and file WS and W/O on 16.09.2025. On 12.09.2025, plaintiff has filed the present application u/s 151 of CPC praying for police help against which defendants have filed written objection on 05.12.2025. Since both the parties are on record, petition for temporary injunction was heard on merit on 05.12.2025 and an order was passed on 13.01.2026 after modifying the restraining order to the extent of status quo. As the plaintiff has filed the present petition over the incident occurred since the month of August 2025, wherein order of temporary injunction in the form of status quo was passed on 13.01.2026. Therefore, the instant petition becomes redundant in the light of modification of ad interim injunction order and is liable to be rejected.

Hence, it is,

Ordered

that petition dated 06.09.2025 u/s 151 of CPC filed by the plaintiff is considered and rejected without any order as to cost.
