Accused person Vivek Deo Chaudhury and Raju Darjee are produced from J/C and they are remanded to J/C till 02.05.2022.

Ld. Addl. P.P. Mr. M. Ali and also the Ld. advocate for the accused persons Mr. Bhaskar Subba are present.

Ld. advocate Miss. Anita Pariyar files a petition praying for bail of the accused person Anil Kumar.

Today is fixed for hearing the bail petition filed for the two accused persons namely Vivek Deo Chaudhury and Raju Darjee.

C.D is produced by the I.O.

The bail petition is taken up for hearing.

Heard both sides.

It is submitted by the Ld. defence counsel that the accused persons namely Vivek Deo Chaudhury and Raju Darjee are in custody since 09.02.2022 and there is no such prayer by the I.O for extension of time. Apart from that, the seized materials do not fall under the category of commercial quantity and as such they should be granted bail.

On the other hand, Ld. Addl. P.P. Mr. M. Ali submits that the statutory period is over and there is also no such prayer by the I.O for extension of time.

Perused the bail petition, C.D and the other materials available on record.

It appears that the accused persons are in custody since 09.02.2022 and no such prayer has been filed by the I.O for extension of time. It is also clear that the seized articles do not fall under the category of commercial quantity.

Considering the above facts and circumstances, the accused persons namely Vivek Deo Chaudhury and Raju Darjee may find bail of Rs. 3000/- with two registered sureties of Rs. 1500/- each subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kalimpong I/d to J/C.

If on bail, the accused persons are directed to meet the I.O once in a week till further order.

The bail petition filed for the accused person Anil Kumar by the Ld. Senior Counsel Mr. Anmol Prasad and Miss. Anita Pariyar be heard on 02.05.2022 i.e on the date of the production of the accused person Anil Kumar before this court.

C.D be returned with further direction to produce the C.D on 02.05.2022.
