COMMITMENT ORDER

1. Accused has been sent to this Court by the Station House Officer, Doraha to face trial for commission of offences punishable under Sections 363/366-A of Indian Penal Code.
2. The present case has been registered on the statement of Ram Bilas Sada son of Phulesawar Sada, resident of Sri Purmowan, P.S. Singia,

District Darbanga, Bihar, at present resident of Rammi Bajwa's Quarter, village Doraha. He stated that he is a labourer and married. That he is having five children i.e two sons and three daughters. That his daughter Sundri aged about 11 years was not studying and is staying at home. That one Kuldeep Kumar son of Galu Kamati, resident of Dasaut P.S. Samastipur, Bihar, at present resident of Rammi Bajwa's Quarter, Village Doraha lived near their quarter. On 18.2.2024, he and his wife left their daughters, Sundari and Gungum at home. When they returned home at around 3:00P.M, his daughter Sundari was not present at home. They thought that she would be playing outside but his daughter Sundari did not come home and they started looking for her. They could not find his daughter Sundari. He came to know that Kuldeep Kumar who lived in the quarter next to her quarter is also not present and had suspicion that Kuldeep Kumar has taken his daughter Sundari with him somewhere under the guise of marriage. That they have been searching for their daughter Sundari but they have not found their daughter Sundari anywhere. That he has believed that his daughter Sundari has been taken away by Kuldeep Kumar under false pretense of marriage. On the basis of his statement, an FIR was registered. Investigation started. During the course of investigation statements of witnesses were recorded. Accused was arrested and after completion of investigation challan was presented in the court against the accused by the police.

3. On appearance of accused, copies of challan and other documents relied upon by the prosecution were supplied to retainer counsel

of accused free of costs as mandated under Section 207 of Code of Criminal Procedure 1973 (Cr.P.C).

4. From the perusal of the report, under section 173 Cr.P.C and documents appended therewith particularly the statement of complainant commission of offences under Sections 363, 366A of Indian Penal Code are made out against the accused. The offence **Under Section 366A of IPC** is exclusively triable by the Ld. Court of Sessions. Hence, the present case alongwith accused person is committed for trial to the Court of Sessions for 07.06.2024. Jail authorities are directed to produce the accused before the Learned Sessions Court on the date fixed at sharp 10:00 AM. Ahlmad is directed to send the file to the Ld. Court of Sessions, Ludhiana complete in all respects before the said date. Prosecution is also intimated for appearance before Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Ludhiana for the date fixed.
