

**Title Suit no. 02/2025 (CIS 02/2025)**

**Order no. 19 Dated 22.07.2026**

The record is put up today.

The parties filed an application before the Court stating that as per preliminary decree vide Order no. 18 dated 30.06.2026, the parties have amicably partitioned their suit property by metes and bounds and also prepared the sketch map and as per the agreement of compromise, the amount of Rs. 30,00,000/- has been paid to defendant no. 2. Therefore, the parties pray for passing final decree on the basis of their settlement. The said petition has been filed on affidavit by plaintiff and defendant no. 1, who filed the affidavit for herself and defendant nos. 2 & 3.

On perusal of the sketch map and other documents, receipts by the parties, it is found acceptable.

Hence, it is

**ORDERED**

that the settlement entered in between the parties in terms of Preliminary Decree vide Order no. 18 dated 30.06.2026 along with the sketch map found correct and therefore accepted. The parties are directed to deposit the stamp duty for purpose of drawing of Final Decree.

Sheristadar is directed to do the needful.

Let the case be restored in CIS.
