STATE -VS- HABU GHOSH & JHANTU SARKAR

Order no. 11 dated 19.03.2021

Both the accused persons namely Jhantu Sarkar and Habu Ghosh are produced from J/C. Received report from S.I Md. Shajahan Ali that he has no objection if the personal belongings of accused Jhantu Sarkar being 1 silver chain, ring and 1 watch which were seized are returned to any near relative.

The father of Jhantu Sarkar namely Gourango Sarkar had filed a petition for release of the articles.

The I.O of this case is directed to return the personal belongings of accused Jhantu Sarkar to his father after proper identification.

Bail petition is filed on behalf of both the accused persons and moved. It is submitted that the seizure list is vague.

Ld. P.P raises objection.

On perusal of the seizure list it appears that commercial quantity of ganja was recovered from the accused persons. There is nothing at this stage to doubt the seizure. In view of the bar under Section 37(1)(b)(ii)O NDPS Act ,prayer for bail is rejected.
