The record is put up by petition.

The petition for reducing the bail amount filed on behalf of accused person namely Basarul Sheikh as the petitioner/accused is unable to furnish Rs.25,000/- as cash security is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused person submits that the accused person Ratan Chettri is too poor to afford Rs.25,000/- as cash security and prays for reducing the amount.

In reply, Ld.Spl.P.P.-in-charge prays for passing necessary order.

Heard both sides.

Perused the petition and the case record.

It appears that the accused person was granted bail on 03-11-2022 directing him to furnish the cash of security of Rs.25,000/- on condition to appear before this Court on every date of hearing, and to meet the I.O. of this case every Monday till submission of supplementary charge sheet along with chemical examination report, but has failed to furnish the same even after 3 months of the order, from which, it can be inferred that the accused person is finding difficult to arrange the cash security.

Thus, the prayer is allowed and the accused person namely Basarul Sheikh be released on furnishing of cash security of **Rs.12,000/-** instead of Rs.25,000/- subject to the satisfaction of Ld. ACJM, Siliguri.

The order dt.03-11-2022 is hereby modified to this extent and other portion of the order has remained as it was before.
