Today is fixed for SR of O.P. No. 1/owner and O.P.No. 2/Insurance company.

Hajira for claimants is filed.

Insurance company enters into appearance and hajira for insurance company is filed. A vokatnama executed by an executive of insurance company and accepted by ld. Lawyer Gopal Chandra Ram is filed. Let the same be kept in the record.

Written statement is filed by insurance company. Let the same be kept in the record.

Another petition is filed by Insurance company under section 169(2) of M. V. Act praying for direction upon claimants to produce all relevant documents including insurance policy on the ground stated therein.

Another petition is filed by insurance company under section 170 of M. V. Act praying for permission to contest the case on merit on the grounds stated therein.

The petition filed by Insurance company under section 170 of M. V. Act is now taken up for consideration.

Heard ld. Lawyer for insurance company. No opposition is raised from the side of claimants. Perused the petition and record as well. Insurance company has prayed for contesting the case on merit. I, therefore, find merit in the petition of insurance company which of why same needs to be allowed.

Thus, prayer of insurance company is allowed. They are permitted to contest the claim on merit. They are at liberty to file additional WS on the next date fixed. **Petition, thus, stands disposed of.**

Next petition in queue is petition under section 169(2) of M. V. Act which is now taken up for consideration.

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Heard ld. Lawyer for insurance company. No objection is raised from the side of claimants. Perused the petition and record as well. Considered. To contest the claim in proper perspective, indeed, documents as mentioned in their petition would be required by insurance company. I, therefore, am inclined to allow their prayer. Thus, prayer contained in the petition is allowed. Claimants are directed to produce all the documents in original and xerox, as asked for by Insurance company by the next date to be fixed. The petition, thus, stands disposed of.

SR of O. P No. 1/owner has not been returned back. In view thereof, claimants are directed to file fresh requisites in respect of O. P No. 1/owner by the next date to be fixed.

It further appears that claimants have not filed DCF as yet. They are directed to pay the DCF by the next date fixed. They are further directed to file their up-to-date bank accounts details by the next date fixed.

Next date is fixed on **06.03.26** for filing of requisites by claimants in respect of O. P No. 1/owner, filing of additional WS, if any, by the insurance company, payment of DCF and furnishing of up-to-date bank account details by the claimants and further order.
