

:- Order Below Exhibit – 1:-

The complainant as well as the Ld. APP are appeared before the court today. The Pursis of compounding of offence has been placed on record by the owner of the property stolen. The de facto complainant/ the owner of the property stolen has signed on the Pursis affirming that he is compounding such offence with his own willing . Perusing the record of the case, where an accused has been booked under Section 379/381/411/414 R/w section 114 of IPC, which is compoundable by the owner of the property stolen as per Section 320(2) of CrPC. The owner of the property wants to compound the offence as he/she has got his stolen prooerty back. Therefore, the accused shall stand acquitted keeping in the consideration of section 320(2) & 320 (8) of the CrPC. Further more if interim order of subjected muddamal is passed than will be permanent and for the rest of the muddamal, will be handed over after conducting due inquiry and if no one claims than will be disposed off as per law. And if an accused is under trial prisoner(UTP) than concerned jail authority is to be ordered to be release him immidiately and immidiate yadi to be communicated to the concerned jail authority.
