

**MACC 143 of 2020**

Order No.20, dated 30.07.2025

Today is fixed for P.H.

Ld. Advocate on behalf of the claimant is present by filing hazira.

Claimant also files examination-in-chief of Suklal Murmu. Let it be kept with the record.

OP No.2/National Insurance Co. Ltd. is also present by filing hazira. He also files a petition u/S 170 of M.V.Act.

The petition u/S 170 of M.V.Act being formal in nature, is hereby allowed.

OP No.2 is permitted to contest the case.

However, after hearing of both sides, it appears that there is possibility of settlement of the issue by mediation.

As such, the parties to the instant MACC case and/or their learned Advocates are requested to attend mediation center.

The above parties and Advocates will report to the Learned Secretary, DLSA, Purba Medinipur on **04.08.2025** who will appoint a Mediator in the meantime.

If it is not possible to mediate this case on the date fixed, the Mediation Centre/Ld. Mediator will arrange a future date for mediation convenient to the parties, if necessary.

Having regard to the nature of the case, the fees of the Ld. Mediator be fixed at a consolidated amount of Rs.2,000/- in terms of existing Mediation Rules, on settlement of the case through mediation.
