Ld. Counsel for all the defendants submits that he has already filed e-copy of the written statement along with affidavit of admission/denial of documents and physical copy thereof shall be filed within the course of the day. He further submits that advance copy thereof has already been supplied to Ld. Counsel for plaintiff. Ld. Counsel for plaintiff confirms the same.

It is not disputed that there is delay of 48 days in filing the written statement.

Ld. Counsel for plaintiff confirms that subject to heavy cost the same may be allowed to take on record.

In view of the concession given by Ld. Counsel for plaintiff, written statement is taken on record, subject to cost of Rs.9000/-, which must be paid within seven days to the plaintiff. It is made clear to defendant that in case cost is not paid within seven days, it will be deemed that defendant is not willing to get the written statement on record.
