Order No.02, dt. 04.06.2026 :

This is an anticipatory bail application u/S-482 of B.N.S.S. moved by the Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioners, namely, **1) Jayanta Santra, 2) Ashok Santra @ Ashok Kumar Santra and 3) Namita Santra @ Namita Rani Santra** praying for anticipatory bail.

It is stated in the petition that no other bail petition is filed or pending or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

The Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioners and the Ld. P.P both are found present.

Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioners submits that these accused-petitioners are husband and in-laws of the de facto complainant. These accused-petitioners are innocent and falsely implicated in this case. As such, he has prayed for anticipatory bail of the accused-petitioners in any condition.

Ld. P.P in-charge refers to the C.D and raises strong objection against accused-petitioner no. 2 namely, **Ashok Santra @ Ashok Kumar Santra.**

Heard both sides. Considered.

Perused the written complaint, statement recorded u/S-180 & 183 of B.N.S.S., medical report and other relevant materials available in the C.D. and T.C.R. Considering the materials on record and the involvement of the accused-petitioner no. 2 in the alleged incident, this Court is not inclined to allow his prayer for anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the accused-petitioner no. 2, namely **Ashok Santra @ Ashok Kumar Santra** stands **rejected.**

However, considering the materials on record against the accused-petitioners no. 1 & 3, this Court is inclined to allow their prayer for anticipatory bail.

Hence, in the event of arrest the accused-petitioner no. 1 & 3, namely, **Jayanta Santra, and Namita Santra @ Namita Rani Santra** be released on bail by executing bond of **Rs. 5,000/- each** with two registered sureties of **Rs.2,500/-** each, subject to the satisfaction of arresting officer. The accused-petitioner to comply the provisions u/S-482(2) of B.N.S.S.

Crl. Misc. Case stands disposed of.

C.D. & T.C.R be returned.
