Order No.02, dt. 19.03.2026 :

This is an application u/S-482 of B.N.S.S. moved by the Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner, namely, **Kajal Chakraborty @ Kajal Mukherjee** praying for anticipatory bail.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner and the Ld. P.P both are found present.

At the outset, learned Advocate for the accused/petitioner submits that no application for anticipatory bail has earlier been rejected by the Hon'ble Court or is pending for disposal before the Hon'ble Court. Learned Advocate draws the attention of this Court to the affidavit relating to such fact. Ld. PP in charge does not dispute the submission of his ld. counterpart.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner further submits that F.I.R. allegation is totally false and motivated and out of previous grudge this case has been falsely instituted and charge sheet has been submitted in this case as investigation is over. He has further submitted that this accused/petitioner has complied with notice under Section 35(3) of B.N.S.S. He thus prayed for anticipatory bail of the accused/petitioner on any condition.

Ld. P.P in-charge refers to the C.D and raises objection.

Heard both sides. Considered.

Perused the petition, case record and C.D. as well.

Investigation is over meaning thereby stage of collection of evidence is also over. Injuries of the de facto complainant and her husband are simple in nature. I, therefore, find no ground to refuse the anticipatory bail of the present accused/petitioner as it would not serve any purpose for a fair trial. Hence, prayer for anticipatory bail of the accused/petitioner is allowed.

In the event of arrest, the accused/petitioner namely, **Kajal Chakraborty @ Kajal Mukherjee**, be released on bail by executing bond of **Rs. 3,000/-** with one registered surety, subject to the satisfaction of arresting officer and on condition that she shall abide by the provisions as enumerated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. and **shall surrender before the Court of ld. A.C.J.M.-II, Haldia, Purba Medinipur within two weeks from the date of passing of this order, i.d., the order for bail shall automatically stand cancelled.**

CrI. Misc. Case stands disposed of.
