**Order No.02, dt. 25.03.2026 :**

This is an application u/S-482 of B.N.S.S. moved by the Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioners, namely, **1) Samaresh Paul, 2) Suman Pal @ Suman Chandra Pal, 3) Radharani Pal, 4) Banshibadan Pal** and **5) Shefali Pal** praying for anticipatory bail.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioners and the Ld. P.P both are found present.

At the outset, learned Advocate for the accused/petitioners submits that no application for anticipatory bail has earlier been rejected by the Hon'ble Court or is pending for disposal before the Hon'ble Court. Learned Advocate draws the attention of this Court to the affidavit relating to such fact. Ld. PP in charge does not dispute the submission of his ld. counterpart.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioners submits that there is property dispute between the parties for which a civil suit is also pending and there is case and counter case between the parties and these accused/petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. He, thus, prays for anticipatory bail of the accused/petitioners on any condition. In support of his contention, Ld. Advocate has filed some documents by firisti.

Ld. P.P in-charge refers to the C.D and raises objection.

The de facto complainant and injured are present by filing hazira along with vokatatnama and some photocopies of documents. Ld. Advocate appearing for the de facto complainant and injured raises objection against the prayer for anticipatory bail of the accused/petitioners.

Heard both sides. Considered.

Perused the petition, case record and C.D. as well.

The injuries of the injured except the wife of the complainant are simple in nature. The injury of the wife of the complainant appears to be grievous. As per the complaint, said injury was caused by accused Banamali Paul with wooden battam, though in his statement u/S. 183 of B.N.S.S., he pointed out his finger at the accused/petitioner no. 1 Samaresh Paul. In view of nature of injury caused to the wife of the complainant, at this stage, I am not inclined to exercise the discretion of anticipatory bail in favour of accused/petitioner no. 1 Samaresh Paul since his name has transpired as the person who allegedly caused fracture injury to the hand of the wife of the complainant with wooden battam. However, so far as the allegation against other accused/petitioners is concerned, materials so available in C.D., do not reveal any justification for their apprehension for custodial interrogation for advancement of further course of investigation. As such, they may be given the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the **accused/petitioner no. 1 namely, Samaresh Paul** stands **rejected** and the prayer for anticipatory bail of the **accused/petitioners no. 2 to 5** stands **allowed**.

In the event of arrest, the accused/petitioners no. 2 to 5 namely, **Suman Pal @ Suman Chandra Pal, Radharani Pal, Banshibadan Pal** and **Shefali Pal**, be released on bail by executing bond of **Rs. 3,000/-** each with one registered surety each of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of arresting officer and on condition that they shall abide by the provisions as enumerated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. and **with further condition that they shall surrender before the Court of Id. C.J.M., Purba Medinipur within two weeks from the date of passing of this order, i.d., the order for bail shall automatically stand cancelled.**

Crl. Misc. Case stands disposed of.

C.D. & T.C.R be returned.
