Today is fixed for hearing of the petition dated 17.12.2021 filed by Rajdeb Shaw for juvenility of accused Anik Shaw @ Ankit.

An adjournment petition is filed on behalf of Ankit Shaw for hearing of application dated 17.12.2021.

Meanwhile, a bail petition is filed on behalf of accused Chandan Barman, on the ground stated therein.

Adjournment petition for hearing of the application dated 17.12.2021 is allowed as last chance.

The bail petition filed on behalf of accused Chandan Barman is taken up for hearing.

The Ld. Counsel on behalf of accused Chandan Barman submits before the court that the said accused person was falsely implicated and never had any role in the commission of alleged offence. He has agitated before the court that he was the mere passenger in the bus in question and was not in physical or even conscious possession of contraband articles.

Ld. P. P. Incharge raised strong objection contending inter alia that contraband of commercial quantity was recovered from the possession of the accused persons praying for bail, as well as the accused persons who have not prayed for bail.

This is a case u/s. 20(b)(ii)(C) of NDPS Act. Seizure of 71 kgs of ganja was allegedly made from the possession of the accused person and six others, which brings this case within the ambit of Section 37 of N.D.P.S Act. Investigation is still at its nascent stage. Considering the incriminating materials in the case docket coupled with the embargo upon the court u/s. 37 of the NDPS Act, prayer for bail of accused Chandan Barman is considered and rejected.
