Since OP.No.1 is not contesting the case as appeared from the earlier order, OP.No.2 should be given the option to contest the claim of claimants on all grounds including the grounds which could be available to OP.No.1. I, therefore find merit in the petition of OP.No.2. Thus, OP.No.2 is permitted to contest the case on merit in terms of section 170 of M.V Act. The petition thus stands disposed of.

It further appears from the case record that the claimants have not paid DCF. Therefore, they are directed to pay DCF either on the next date or in all probability, before delivery of judgement. They are further directed to furnish Aadhaar cards, PAN cards, bank accounts details and email, if any, by the next date if not furnished meanwhile.

Next date fixed on **10.04.2026** for payment of DCF by claimants and furnishing of Aadhaar cards, PAN cards, bank accounts details and email, if any, by them, if not furnished meanwhile and framing of issues.
