Order No.02, dt. 04.06.2026 :

This is an application u/S-482 of B.N.S.S. moved by the Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioners, namely, 1) **Tapan Jana**, 2) **Rinku Jana**, 3) **Swarup Jana**, 4) **Sanku Jana**, 5) **Jayashree Samanta Jana** and 6) **Chandana Bera Jana @ Chandana Bera**, praying for anticipatory bail.

It is stated in the petition that no other bail petition is filed or pending or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

The Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioners and the Ld. P.P both are found present.

Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioners submits that except Section 109 of B.N.S., all other sections are magistrate triable. There is land dispute in between the parties. There is also case and counter case in between the parties. The F.I.R. allegation is nothing but a concocted story. As such, he has prayed for enlarging the accused-petitioners on anticipatory bail on any condition. In support of his contention he filed some documents under the cover of firisti.

Ld. P.P refers the C.D and raises objection.

Heard both sides. Considered.

Perused the written complaint, statement recorded u/S-180 of B.N.S.S., medical report and other relevant materials available in the C.D. and T.C.R. It appears from the medical report that the injuries is simple in nature. Civil dispute is pending between the parties. I have also perused the counter case being Bhabanipur P.S. Case no. 59 of 2026 dated 24.02.2026.

Considering the materials on record and counter case, I am of the opinion that custodial interrogation of the accused-petitioners is not highly required and accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the accused-petitioners is **allowed**.

In the event of arrest, the accused-petitioners namely, **Tapan Jana**, **Rinku Jana**, **Swarup Jana**, **Sanku Jana**, **Jayashree Samanta Jana** and **Chandana Bera Jana @ Chandana Bera** be released on bail by executing bond of **Rs. 5,000/-** each with two registered sureties of **Rs.2,500/-** each, subject to the satisfaction of arresting officer. The accused-petitioners to comply the provisions u/S-482(2) of B.N.S.S.

Crl. Misc. Case stands disposed of.

C.D. & T.C.R be returned.
