Today is fixed for filing show cause by the claimant.

Ld. Advocate for the claimant is present along with answer to the show cause.

Copy served. The cause shown seems satisfactory **hence accepted.**

Ld. Advocate for the claimants today also files three petitions.

By filing the first application Ld. Advocate for the claimants prays to amend the address of the claimant no. 3 namely Ipsita Barh on the ground of her marriage.

One self attested AADHAAR card of this claimant is also filed.

Heard. Perused the petition as well as the AADHAAR Card.

It appears that the amendment as sought for is formal in nature and if allowed, will not change the nature and character of this case. Hence the petition for changing the address of claimant no. 3 as mentioned in the schedule of the petition, **is allowed.**

Now the petition filed by the claimant no. 2 is taken up for hearing.

By filing this application claimant no. 2 Ankita Barh prays to allow her to proceed with the instant case by herself as she attained majority. Self attested xerox copy of AADHAAR card of claimant no. 2 is also filed.

It also appeared that the date of birth of claimant no. 2 is 14-10-2003.

From the original claim application it appears that at the time of institution of the present MAC case, claimant no. 2 was minor and she was represented by her natural guardian mother.

But now, claimant no. 2 became major during the pendency of the case and accordingly, she is permitted to proceed with the instant case on her own behalf.

Let the vokalatnama filed on behalf of claimant no. 2 be kept with the record.

Now the petition under order 6 rule 17 is taken up for hearing.

By filing this application Ld. Advocate prays to amend the claim application as per schedule of the application on the ground stated therein.

Heard. Consided. It appears that the amendment sought for, is formal in nature and will not change the nature and character of the case if allowed. Rather to avoid future multiplicity, this petition should be allowed.

Hence the petition for amendment, as per schedule of the petition, stands allowed.

Claimants are directed to file fresh amended claim application by the next date positively.
