Today is fixed for hearing of the petition dt. 27/11/2025, payment of DCF and furnishing of details of Aadhaar cards, Pan cards, bank account details and e-mail, if any, by the claimants and evidence.

Hajira for claimants is filed.

Hajira for insurance company is filed.

Record is taken up for hearing of the petition dt. 27/11/2025 being filed by claimant No.4 Rupsana Khatun.

Heard ld. Lawyer for claimants. No objection is raised from the side of insurance company. Perused the petition and record as well. It appears that when petition for compensation was filed, claimant No.4 was minor but during the pendency of the case, she has become major and as such, she has filed a petition to continue the proceeding with other claimants but in her independent capacity without being any more represented by her mother, and to this end, a vokatname executed by her and accepted by her ld. Lawyer is also filed. I, therefore, find no ground to disallow her prayer.

Hence her prayer is allowed. She is permitted to continue the proceeding in her independent capacity as one of the claimants. Let a note to this end be given to the cause title of petition for compensation as well as relevant register.

The petition thus stands disposed of.

As DCF is not paid, claimants are again directed to pay the DCF on the next date. They are further directed to furnish their up to date bank account details by the next date fixed so that if their claim succeeds, claim amount can directly be credited to their bank account by insurance company

Next date is fixed on 07.03.2026 for payment of DCF, furnishing of bank account details and evidence.
