Order No.04 dt. 14.07.2026 :

This is an application u/S-482 of B.N.S.S. moved by the Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioner, namely, **Sk Alamgir** praying for anticipatory bail.

It is stated in the petition that no other bail petition is filed or pending or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

The Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioner and the Ld. P.P both are found present.

Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioner submits that the accused-petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case. This accused-petitioner is in no way connected with the alleged incident. Some of the co-accused persons are on bail. As such, he has prayed for anticipatory bail on any condition. In support of his contention, he has filed some documents under the cover of firisiti.

Ld. P.P refers the C.D and raises strong objection.

Heard both sides. Considered.

Perused the written complaint, statement recorded u/S-180 of B.N.S.S., seizure list and other relevant materials available in the C.D. and T.C.R. It appears from the case record that main allegation is against this accused-petitioner. Investigation is going on.

Considering the materials on record, nature and gravity of offence and involvement of the accused-petitioner in the alleged offence, the prayer for anticipatory bail of this accused-petitioner namely, **Sk Alamgir** is **rejected**.

Crl. Misc. Case stands disposed of.
