Fresh vakalatnama filed today on behalf of the
accused. Taken on record.

Arguments on charge heard. There is prima facie
material on record to frame charge.

Charge for the offence **U/s. 363 IPC** has been
framed against the accused to which he pleaded not guilty and
claimed trial.

PW-1 Ms. Shivani and PW2 Dharamlal are
examined, cross-examined and discharged.

Statement of accused u/s 294 Cr PC recorded.

In view of the same, Ld. APP for the State submits
that witnesses mentioned at serial no. 5, 6 & 8 need not be called
for examination. Accordingly, the same are dropped from the list
of witnesses.

Ld counsel for accused person submits that nothing
incriminating against the accused has come on record in the
testimonies of PW1 and PW2 and that no purpose will be served
in examining the remaining witnesses.

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Heard. Record perused.

There appears no purpose in completing the formality of trial. Reliance is placed upon the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in '*Satish Mehra v. Delhi Administration & Anr. [(1996) 9 SCC 766]*', wherein it was held that –

“15. But when the Judge is fairly certain that there is no prospect of the case ending in conviction the valuable time of the Court should not be wasted for holding a trial only for the purpose of formally completing the procedure to pronounce the conclusion on a future date...”

Accordingly, the examination of the remaining witnesses being official witnesses stands dispensed with as no fruitful purpose will be served by examining remaining witnesses. In view of the same, witnesses are hereby dropped from the list of witnesses and statement u/s 313 Cr PC stands dispensed with as no incriminating evidence has come on record.

Final arguments heard.
