Order No.08 dated 18.10.2023

Today is fixed for hearing of bail petition dated 17.10.2023 is taken up for hearing.

Ld. P.P. in-charge and the Ld. Advocate for the accused person are present.

Heard both the sides. Perused the petition for bail as well as the materials on record.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person prays for bail on any condition submitting that the alleged quantity of 'ganja' was recovered from the possession of the accused person is 6 kgs. which is not commercial quantity.

Ld. Advocate further submits that the accused person is in jail custody for 54 days.

Ld. P.P in-charge raises vehement objection against the prayer for bail submitting that total 6 kgs of contraband 'ganja' has been recovered from the possession of the accused person.

On careful perusal it appears that total 6 kgs. of 'ganja' was recovered from the possession of the accused person which is intermediate quantity. It appears that the accused person is in jail custody for 54 days.

Having heard the submissions of both the sides and considering the period of detention and the ensuing Puja Vacation, I am inclined to enlarge the accused person on bail.

Hence, the accused **Sk. Rafikul** may find interim bail of Rs.20,000/- with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each of like amount, one of whom must be local surety.

The petition for bail is accordingly disposed of.
