Order No.02 dt. 06.06.2026 :

This is an application u/S-483 of B.N.S.S. moved by the Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioners, namely, **1) Nasiruddin Mallik** and **2) Rafique Mallik @ Rafik Mallik** praying for bail.

It is stated in the petition that no other bail petition is filed or pending or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

The Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioners and the Ld. P.P both are found present.

Ld. Advocate for the accused-petitioners submits that there is no specific allegation against the present accused-petitioners. These accused-petitioners are innocent and falsely implicated in this case. They are in custody since 27.05.2026. Some of the co-accused persons are on bail. As such, considering the period of detention, the prayer for bail of the accused-petitioners may be allowed.

Ld. P.P refers the C.D and raises strong objection.

Heard both sides. Considered.

Perused the written complaint, statement recorded u/S-180 of B.N.S.S., medical report and other relevant materials available in the C.D. and T.C.R. It appears from the medical report that the injury is not so serious. The present accused-petitioners are in custody since 27.05.2026. Some of the co-accused persons are on bail.

Considering the materials on record, I am of the opinion that further detention of the accused-petitioners is not highly required and accordingly, the prayer for bail of the accused-petitioners is **allowed**.

Accordingly, accused-petitioners, namely, **1) Nasiruddin Mallik** and **2) Rafique Mallik @ Rafik Mallik** may find bail on executing bond of **Rs. 5,000/-** each with two registered sureties of **Rs. 2,500/-** each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. C.J.M., Purba Medinipur, i.d. to J/C.

Crl. Misc. Case stands disposed of.

C.D. & T.C.R be returned.

Let a copy of this order, along with the T.C.R., be sent to the Ld. C.J.M., Purba Medinipur for information and necessary action.
