Today is fixed for hearing of petition dated 12.04.2017.

Plaintiffs file hazira. Petition dated 12.04.2017 is taken up for hearing.

In the instant petition, plaintiff no. 7 Smt. Dipali Das has prayed for expunging her as party from this suit. Ld. Advocate for the plaintiffs has raised objection stating that the petitioner has not specifically mentioned her intention while filing this petition, as to whether she wants to disassociate herself from the plaintiffs' group or from the suit itself. Ld. Advocate for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner wants to separate herself from the entire suit and not for the plaintiffs only.

Heard both sides. The objection raised by the Ld. Advocate for the plaintiffs does not appear to be fatal to the instant petition as the intention of the petitioner is unambiguous from the entire reading of the petition itself.

Therefore, the instant petition dated 12.04.2017 is considered and **allowed** without costs.

The petitioner is hereby struck out as a party of this suit.
