Order No. 09, dated 15.06.2018

Accused Subhamoy Chanda is produced from J/C.

One bail petition has been filed on behalf of the said accused person.

De facto complainant of this case files hazira.

Ld. Spl. P.P Goutam Samanta files hazira.

Ld. Spl. P.P and Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused person are present.

As per submission of both sides today's bail petition is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the accused submits that the accused is detaining in J/C for a long period. Ld. Advocate also submits that the accused is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case and he has residence within the jurisdiction of this Court and there is no chance of his absconding. Ld. Advocate prays for bail of the accused in any condition.

Ld. Spl. P.P raises objection submitting that offence is serious in nature and there is sufficient materials against this accused.

Heard. Perused the case record and C.D including the statement of the V.G recorded under Section 164 of the Cr. P.C and medico-legal report of the V.G. Considered.

It appears that offence is serious in nature, under Section 376 of I.P.C and under Section 4 of POCSO Act, 2012. Prima facie there is sufficient materials against the accused. Considering all, prayer for bail is rejected at this stage.

Accused is remanded to J/C till 29.06.2018.
