Order No. 10, dated 29.06.2018

Accused Subhamoy Chanda is produced from J/C.

One bail petition has been filed on behalf of the said accused person.

Ld. Spl. P.P Goutam Samanta and Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused person are present.

As per submission of both sides today's bail petition is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the accused submits that the accused is detaining in J/C since 18.05.2018. Ld. Advocate also submits that the accused is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case and he is a student of Khejuri College and he has residence within the jurisdiction of this Court and there is no chance of his absconding. Ld. Advocate prays for bail in any condition.

Ld. Spl. P.P raises objection submitting that offence is serious in nature.

Heard. Perused the case record and C.D. Considered.

It appears that offence is serious in nature, under Section 376 of I.P.C and under Section 4 of POCSO Act, 2012. Prima facie there is sufficient materials against the accused. Considering all, prayer for bail is rejected at this stage.

Accused is remanded to J/C till 12.07.2018.
