

**Sessions Case No.116 of 2026**

**Order No.03, dated 17.03.2026**

Today is fixed for production of accused and I.O's report.

Accused persons namely, Gopal Jana and Anjan Jana are produced through V.C and remanded to J.C.

Accused Bishnupada Jana is produced from P.C. He is remanded to J.C till next date.

Received accused return challan, Seizure List dated 15.03.2026 and Inspection Memo from the I.O. Let the same be kept with the record.

Bail application has been filed on behalf of all the three accused persons namely, 1) Bishnupada Jana, 2) Anjan Jana & 3) Gopal Jana.

Defacto complainant is present personally through his Ld. Advocate by filing vokalatnama.

**In the meantime, bail application for accused Bishnupada Jana is rejected as “not pressed”.**

Bail application for accused Gopal Jana and Anjan Jana is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the accused submitted that both of them were arrested on 20.02.2026. After their arrest, neither their P.C was demanded nor any incriminating material whatsoever has been found from their possession. Investigation of this case, after their arrest, has not yet been progressed any further in respect of these two petitioners. Ld. Advocate prays for allowing the bail application.

Defacto complainant who was present in the Court has made submission that he has no allegation agaisnt these two accused persons and has no objection if they may be enlarged on bail.

Ld. P.P-in-charge though raises objection but could not make any such submissions by which the prima facie acquisition of the accused/petitioner are made out.

Considered the rival submissions of both the sides as well as on perusal of materials on C.D. Considering the period of detention of the accused/petitioners and also considering the fact that defacto complainant raises no objection agaisnt the bail prayer, this court is inclined to grant the bail application.

Thus, the bail application is allowed.

Accordingly, accused/petitioners namely, 1) Gopal Jana and 2) Anjan Jana may find interim bail of Rs.10,000/- each with two registered sureties of Rs.5,000/- each with a direction to appear before the I.O as and when they have been called for till completion of investigation, subject to the satisfaction and acceptance by the Ld. ACJM, Contai i/e to J.C.

Fix **31.03.2026** for appearance, production of accused Bishnupada Jana.

Let a copy of the order be sent to the Ld. ACJM, Contai for information and necessary action.
