Order No. 06, dated 07-04-2026

Today is fixed for production, appearance, hearing of the bail application dated 31-03-2026 and IO's Report.

Accused person namely Bishnupada Jana is produced from JC through VC and remanded to JC till the next date.

Other two accused persons on interim bail are present and by filing a petition prays for confirmation of their bail.

Ld. Special PP is present.

The informant is also present along with his Ld. Advocate.

No report is received from the IO.

The bail petition dated 31-03-2026 is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person submitted that the accused person is totally innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. It is submitted that the accused person is in no manner connected with the alleged incident. It is further submitted that the present case had arising out of a misunderstanding. It is submitted that the accused person is in custody since 20-02-2026 and over the period the investigation of the case would have progressed a lot and all vital evidences must have been collected and as such there is no scope to tamper with the evidence. It is also submitted that no bail prayer of the accused person has been rejected by any superior forum. It is submitted that the accused person is a permanent resident within the jurisdiction of this Court and will not abscond if released on bail and will face the trial.

Strong objection is taken by Ld. Special PP who submits that the present accused person is the principal accused of this case. It is submitted that there are sufficient materials in the CD regarding the involvement of the accused person in the alleged offence and the investigation of the case is still going on. It is submitted that the release of the accused person on bail would hamper the investigation.

The Ld. Advocate for the informant submitted that the informant has no objection if the accused person is released on bail and that the informant has filed an affidavit in this regard before the Court.

Perused the bail applications and considered the submissions of bot the sides in the light of the materials in the case diary and case record.

On perusal of the case record and the case diary it is found that during the investigation of the case, the statement of the victim girl has been recorded in terms of S. 183 BNSS and there is grave allegation against the present accused person. But the medical examination report of the victim girl, lying in the case diary, does not support the case of the prosecution. Moreover, the informant has also raised no objection regarding the grant of bail to the accused person.

Considering the above facts and circumstances coupled with the period of detention of the accused person, this Court is inclined to release the accused person on bail and the prayer for bail stands allowed.

Accordingly, accused **Bishnupada Jana** may be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000.00 with two registered sureties of Rs, 5,000.00 each subject to the satisfaction and acceptance of Ld. ACJM at Contai.

Let a copy of this order be sent to the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M, Contai, Purba Medinipur for information and necessary action.

Let a soft copy of this order be also forwarded to the Superintendent, Contai Subsidiary Correctional Home for initiating the same to the accused person named above as per direction of the Hon'ble Apex Court in case of Policy Strategy for Grant of Bail being SNWP (Criminal) No. 04 of 2021.
