

Order No. 02, dated 24.06.2019

Accused Siddeswar Das is produced today from J/C.

One bail petition has been filed on behalf of said accused person.

Ld. Special P.P Sri Sandip Maity files hazira.

Ld. Special P.P and Ld. Advocate for accused are present.

As per submission of both sides, today's bail petition is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the accused submits that the accused is detaining in J/C for a long period; he is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

Ld. Advocate prays for bail of this accused in any condition.

Ld. Special P.P raises objection submitting that the offence is serious in nature and there is sufficient materials against this accused in C.D.

Heard. Perused the case record and C.D. Considered.

It appears that the offence is serious in nature, under Section 341/323/506/509/354A/306 of the I.P.C and under Section 8 of the POCSO Act. Prima facie there is sufficient materials against this accused. Considering all, prayer for bail is rejected at this stage.
