

Order No. 04, dated 09.07.2020

As fixed, the case record is taken up for hearing of the bail application, filed on behalf of accused Subal Kumar Maity.

Sri Santanu Hota, Ld. Advocate files an affidavit swearing that no application for bail of said accused has been filed or moved before the Hon'ble High Court or no such application is now pending before the Hon'ble Court for consideration.

Heard both sides through video conferencing.

Ld. Advocate for accused person prays bail submitting that the accused is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case and he is in J/C since 15.11.2019. Ld. Advocate also submits that investigation is over and charge has been framed. He prays for bail of the accused in any condition stating that accused has permanent residence within the jurisdiction of this Court.

Heard Ld. Special P.P Sri Sandip Maity in opposition.

Heard both sides. Perused the case record and C.D. Considered.

It appears that the accused is in J/C since 15.11.2019 and charge-sheet has been submitted and charge has been framed. Considering all, the prayer for bail is allowed.

Accordingly, accused Subal Kumar Maity may find bail of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 5,000/- each, one of whom one must be an Advocate, to the satisfaction of the Ld. A.C.J.M, Contai and on further condition that the accused shall not enter the territorial jurisdiction of Bhupatinagar Police Station except for meeting the investigation agency as and when necessary until further orders and he shall provide the address where he shall presently reside, to the investigating agency as well as to this Court.

If on bail, to date (15.07.2020) for appearance and further order.
