

Later dated 30.06.2023

Accused Bimal Sau surrendered before this Court by filing v.nama.

Accused is taken into custody.

Bail application is filed.

It is submitted that the accused has been granted anticipatory bail in Criminal Misc Case No.124 of 2023 on 14.06.2023

Heard both sides.

It appears that this Court in Criminal Misc Case No.124 of 2023 passed the following order.

“Therefore, in the event of arrest, the accused/petitioner Bimal Sau may be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with one registered surety, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to following conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C, 1973 -

- i) that the applicant shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- ii) that the applicant shall not, directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- iii) that the applicant shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.

In view of the above, the application for anticipatory bail is thus disposed of on contest.”

The accused is at liberty to furnish bail bond in terms of anticipatory bail order.
