This is an application under section 482 of BNSS filed by the petitioners namely **1) Biswajit Santra** **2) Swapan Santra** in connection with Jangipara P.S. Case No. 59/2026 dated 22/02/2026 under sections 109(1)/115(2)/117(2)/329(4)/352/76/3(5) of BNSS.

C.D. and L.C.R. are produced.

Ld. P.P. ,Hooghly concedes to the submission of the Id. Advocate of the petitioners that neither any bail application under section 482 of BNSS is pending before the Hon'ble Court nor any such prayer has been rejected by the Hon'ble Court in respect of these petitioners.

Ld. advocate on behalf of the de facto complainant appears by vakalatnama and also files one affidavit stating that the dispute is settled out of the Court between the parties and he has got no objection to the prayer for bail.

Heard the Id. advocate of the petitioners who has submitted that the petitioners and the de facto complainant are uncle and nephew by relation. Ld. advocate prays for anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions.

Ld. P.P. ,Hooghly does not have objection against the bail prayer. However, it is pointed out that the injury report available in the C.D. is not properly prepared and cryptic in nature.

Having heard both sides and after perusal of the materials in the C.D. including the injury report, I am inclined to give the benefit of anticipatory bail in favour of the petitioners. Hence, prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

Accordingly, In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.2,500/- each with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and to comply with the provisions as laid down in sub-section (2) of section 482 of BNS.

CMOH, Hooghly is directed to take necessary measure so that injury reports are prepared in appropriate manner and not in cryptic manner as is available in this particular case prepared by Dr. Debanjan Sinha Roy. Let a copy of this order be forwarded to the CMOH, Hooghly for necessary compliance.

Return the C.D. and L.C.R.

Thus, the Cr. Misc. Case is disposed of.

Let a copy of this order be tagged with the case record.
