This is an application under section 482 of BNSS filed by the petitioner namely **Piyali Ray Paladhi @ Piyali Roy Paladhi** in connection with Serampore P.S. Case No. 20/2026 dated 07/01/2026 under sections 318(4)/ 319(2) /336(2)(3)/338/ 61(2) of BNSS.

C.D. and L.C.R. are produced.

Ld. Additional P.P. , Hooghly concedes to the submission of the Id. Advocate of the petitioner that neither any bail application under section 482 of BNSS is pending before the Hon'ble Court nor any such prayer has been rejected by the Hon'ble Court in respect of these petitioner.

Heard the Id. advocate of the petitioner who has submitted that all the allegations against the petitioner is false and mischievously made out. It is further submitted that the actual dispute lies between the de facto complainant and Aditi Dey. The present petitioner is a practicing psychologist. It is further submitted that the present petitioner has been falsely dragged into this case. Ld. advocate prays for anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions.

Ld. Additional P.P. raising objection against the bail prayer has pointed out to the materials collected in the C.D.

Having heard both sides and after perusal of the materials collected in the C.D. , I find that the present petitioner has co-operated with the I.O. and produced her documents.

Considering the nature of allegation and the materials available in the C.D., I do not think that the petitioner is required to be interrogated in custody. So, I am inclined to give the benefit of anticipatory bail in favour of the petitioner. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail **stands allowed.**

Accordingly, In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.2,500/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and to comply with the provisions as laid down in sub-section (2) of section 482 of BNSS.

Return the C.D. and L.C.R.

Thus, the Cr. Misc. Case is disposed of.
