Today is fixed for hearing petition u/o 6 r 17 of Civil Procedure Code filed by the petitioner.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate of the petitioner that there is an inadvertent typographical error in the plaint where the date of marriage between between the petitioner and respondent is mistakenly typed as 03.03.2025 and the date of separation between them is mistakenly typed as 18.03.2025 instead of 03.03.2024 and 18.03.2024 respectively.

The Ld. Advocate further submits that those dates appearing on paragraph no. 2 paragraph no. 8 and paragraph. 9 are required to be rectified.

Considered the submissions of the Ld. Advocate of the petitioner, the mistake appears in the case of record is required to be corrected for just adjudication of the case.

Accordingly, the prayer is allowed.

Let the petition u/sec. 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act be amended in terms of schedule to the petition.

Petitioner is directed to file amended plaint.
