ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

Perused the record. The accused is alleged to have committed an offence punishable under section 68(b) of Bombay Prohibition Act.

2] From perusing record of the case, prosecution is totally failed to take steps and secure presence of accused. C.A. report is also not filed in spite of sufficient opportunities.

3] In such circumstances, it appears to me that no purpose would be served by keeping the matter pending. Therefore, in view of the provision of section 281 of B.N.S.S., it appears to me that it is a fit case to stop the proceeding. Hence, the following order :

ORDER

1. This proceeding against accused is stopped and accused Santosh Balu Mandale is hereby discharged from the offence levelled as per Section 281 of B.N.S.S.
2. Bail bond of the accused stands cancelled.
3. The seized muddemal be sent to State Excise Department for disposal after appeal period is over as per law.
