

Order No. 11 dated 18.11.2025

Record is put-up on the prayer of the accused Suprodip Chatterjee.

In-terms of the order dated 06.11.2025 passed in CRM (M) 2146 of 2025, separate petition has been filed u/s 187 of BNSS with a prayer for statutory bail. Photocopy of the order of the Hon'ble Court has also been filed.

Fresh vakalatnama has been filed on behalf of the accused.

By the said order dated 06.11.2025, the Hon'ble Court has been pleased to pass the following directions:- *“Having considered the fact that the petitioner is detained beyond the statutory period and is entitled to default bail. I direct the learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, 3rd Court, Hooghly to accept the bond furnished on behalf of the petitioner. To that effect, petitioner will take out an appropriate application under Section 187 of the BNSS. Learned Special Court would allow the application and on furnishing of bond to the satisfaction of the learned Special Court, the petitioner may be released.*

*Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**”.*

The petition filed by the petitioner u/s 187 of BNSS is allowed.

Accordingly, the accused person namely Suprodip Chatterjee is directed to furnish bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two registered sureties of Rs.5,000/- each.
