Both the parties file their respective haziras.

Both the petitioners are present in court with their learned Counsels.

Today is fixed for hearing of the application filed by the parties u/s 28 of Special Marriage Act, 1954.

Both the petitioners are examined on dock as PW-1 and P.W-2. Original certificate of marriage and Aadhaar Cards of the parties are marked as Exbt.1, Exbt.2 and Exbt.A.

Heard both the sides. Perused the application and oral testimony of both the petitioners.

According to the petitioners, they are the legally married couple and their marriage was solemnized on 17.01.2020 under Special Marriage Act. After solemnization of marriage, both the parties started residing together as husband and wife in the house of the petitioner no.1 Vivekananda Sen and their marriage was duly consummated, but they have no issue. Their marital life was happy for first few months, thereafter, marital discord started over the issue of differences of opinion, test and culture. Though the parties tried their best to adjust themselves, but in vain. Finally they realized that it would not be possible for them to live together as husband and wife under the same roof and decided to live separately and finally they started residing separately on and from 09.06.2022.

During their examination, both the parties stated before the court that due to differences of opinion, test and culture, it was not possible for them to reside together under the same roof. They further stated that they have no allegation against each other and the petitioner no.2/wife has no claim against the petitioner no.1/husband and they filed the present application voluntarily without being influenced by others.

Considering all the above and also considering the fact that the parties are residing separately since 09.06.2022 and that there was no chance of reunion between the parties, I do not find any reason to disallow the prayer.

Hence, it is

ORDERED

that the application u/s 28 of Special Marriage Act, 1954 filed by the parties stands **allowed.**

Marriage tie in between the petitioner no.1/Vivekananda Sen (husband) and petitioner no.2/Somashree Sen Singha Roy (wife) is dissolved by decree of divorce on mutual consent.

Instant case is disposed of.
