

Misc.Appeal 99/25

The record is taken up for passing orders.

The appeal is heard ex-parte on the last date.

Ld. Advocate for the appellants prays for confirming the ad-interim order of injunction passed in this Misc.Appeal.

The instant Misc.Appeal is preferred against the order of the Ld. Trial Court refusing to grant ex-parte ad-interim injunction. After admission of this instant appeal, an order of ad-interim injunction was passed in favour of the appellants vide order no. 2 dated 29.07.2025, whereby the Court of Ld. District Judge had observed that an ad-interim order of injunction is required to be passed to maintain the present equilibrium in the suit property. An order of ad-interim injunction was allowed whereby the respondents / defendants were restrained by an order of ad-interim injunction from creating any illegal interference in the peaceful possession of the suit property as mentioned in the schedule.

Accordingly, let the ex-parte ad-interim injunction passed in favour of the appellants vide order no. 2 dated 29.07.25 is hereby extended till disposal of the temporary injunction application filed in Title Suit no. 442/25. Hence

ORDERED

The instant Misc.Appeal is allowed ex-parte against the respondents. The respondents are hereby restrained by an order of ad-interim injunction from creating any illegal interference in the peaceful possession of the suit property as mentioned in the schedule till disposal of the temporary injunction application filed in Title Suit no. 442/25. The Trial Court record need not be called for. The instant Misc.Appeal is accordingly disposed of.
