Vikas Sharma Vs State of Punjab

Present: Sh.Suresh Chopra, Advocate for the applicant-accused.

Bail application under Section 482 BNSS received by entrustment. It be registered.

Application for interim order has been made.

Heard. Record perused.

It is submitted that a false case has been registered against the applicant-accused. Offence under Section 115(2) BNS is bailable and Section 74 BNS has been added without any substantial accusation in this respect. Wife of the applicant-accused is on the family way and is due for delivery. In respect of the same, requisite medical record has been placed on record.

It is also submitted that considering the condition of the wife of the applicant-accused, his presence is required to assist her whereas he has apprehension of arrest in the present case. Keeping in view the afore said circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that, before passing any interim bail order it would require perusal of police record. Therefore, police record be called for **09.09.2026**. Notice of the bail application be issued to State for the date fixed.

Applicant-accused be not arrested till 09.09.2026.
