

Mat Suit No. 410 of 2025

Order No. 08 dated 16.06.2026

Today is fixed for exparte hearing.

The petitioner is present by filing hazira and has also filed her examination-in-chief on affidavit and she is examined as P.W.1 and discharged.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner.

Perused the materials on record. On perusal of the record it appears that the petitioner has filed the present suit against her husband u/s 13(1)(ia)(ib) of Hindu Marriage Act for dissolution of their marriage. In spite of service of summons, the respondent has not appeared in this case and the suit is proceeded with an exparte against him.

It is the contention of the petitioner that the marriage between the parties was solemnized on 29.04.1997 according to Hindu Rites and Customs at the paternal house of the petitioner at 37 U.N. Nandi Road, Chhatuganj, P.O. Sheoraphuly, P.S. Serampore, District Hooghly and after marriage they started to reside together as husband and wife and out of their wedlock one male child namely, Jishu Nandi was born on 04.07.1998. It is the allegation of the petitioner that after the birth of male child the respondent and other in-laws started to misbehave with the petitioner and subjected her to cruelty both physically and mentally and demanded Rs.2,00,000/- and ultimately on 22.09.2017 the respondent/husband and other in-laws physically assaulted the petitioner and driven out her from her matrimonial home and the family members of the petitioner had tried to reconcile the matter amicably but it was failed and hence this suit.

In support of the contention of the petitioner, the petitioner has adduced evidence as P.W.1.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and on perusal of the record, it appears to me that the testimony of the petitioner regarding her contention remains unchallenged and there is nothing on record to contradict her contention.

Considering the above, it appears to me that the petitioner is able to prove her case and is entitled to get the relief as prayed for.

Hence, it is,

ORDERED

that the marriage took place in between the petitioner and the respondent on 29.04.1997 as per Hindu Rites and Customs is hereby dissolved by way of decree of divorce u/s 13(1)(ia) of Hindu Marriage Act.
