In view of the submissions of Ld. counsel for the DH

and further the entire decretal amount of Rs.9,24,664/- being admittedly outstanding and payable as on date despite the JD/ MCD having ample time and opportunity to pay the same, this court is constrained to take coercive action the MCD and accordingly, let warrants of attachment be issued for amount of Rs.9,24,664/- against the bank account of the JD/MCD having Account no.41010068213 at SBI, Chandni Chowk Branch, Delhi on PF. Steps be taken within in two weeks from today. DH is directed to file affidavit that there is no stay or appeal pending against the present execution petition alongwith the PF.

It is directed that Manager of the concerned bank shall remit the said amount to the Court after attachment either in the form of bank draft or banker's cheque in the name of DH.
