Today is fixed for ex parte hearing.

Petitioner has also filed an amendment petition today. The matter is now shifted back from the ex parte board to the regular board for hearing of the said amendment petition on this day.

Ld Advocate for the petitioner moved the said petition filed under Order 6 Rule 17 of the CPC for amending the plaint filed by the petitioner in this case as the petitioner has inadvertently written in prayer (a) of the plaint “Hindu Marriage Act, 1954” instead of “Special Marriage Act, 1954” . He submitted that the above amendment was formal in nature and liable to be allowed.

It is apparent that the proposed correction is formal in nature and would not affect the nature and character of the instant suit as the crux of the matter is that the petitioner is praying for divorce in the Mat Suit under the Special Marriage Act, 1954. The petitioner is directed to file the amended plaint and serve a copy of the same upon the respondent.
