The record is put up by petition filed on behalf of the accused/petitioners.

Accused persons namely Samir Ruidas, Shabari Ruidas and Mangal Ruidas have surrendered before the court by filing a surrender petition.

Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused persons is present.

Ld. P.P in-charge is also present.

One bail petition is filed on behalf of the accused persons namely Samir Ruidas, Shabari Ruidas and Mangal Ruidas.

The bail petition is shown served upon the Ld. P.P In-charge.

Ld. advocate submits that the accused persons are falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that the accused persons are innocent and the instant case is totally false and concocted. He further submits that the accused persons have already been complied the direction of notice issued u/s 41(c) from the concerned P.S. He also submits that the accused persons are the residents under the jurisdiction of this court. He further submits that this is a case u/s 8 of the POCSO Act and Section 126(2)/351(2)/352/74 of BNS and highest punishment for the above mentioned offences are up to seven years. He also submits that if the accused/petitioner is released on bail, the accused/petitioner will remain present on each and every date fixed. So, he prays for bail on any terms and condition.

Ld. P.P raised no objection to the bail prayer of the accused/petitioners.

Perused the bail prayer as well as the case record.

Heard both sides.

It appears that this is a case u/s 8 of the POCSO Act and Section 126(2)/351(2)/352/74 of BNS and highest punishment for the above mentioned offences are up to seven years. It also appears that the accused persons have already complied the direction of notice u/s 41(c) served upon them by the concerned P.S. However, today the accused persons surrendered voluntarily. Considering all aspect, this court is inclined to allow the bail prayer of the accused/petitioner.

Accordingly the accused/petitioners namely Samir Ruidas, Shabari Ruidas and Mangal Ruidas may find bail of Rs. 4,000/- each with two surties of Rs. 2,000/- each, to the satisfaction of the Ld. A.C.J.M, Chandannagore on condition that they must remain present on each and every date fixed.
